Insider's Guide TO DANVILLE IMPROVEMENTS

EBMUD Water Line Replacement

PROJECT INFORMATION

The East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) is replacing a 10-inch water line that ruptured on July 4, 2013, which caused pavement damage, flooding and service disruption to customers.

Work to replace the water line will be completed on Diablo Road (Front Street to Diablo Road) and Hartz Avenue (Diablo Road to Railroad Avenue). Expect minor delays Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Two-way traffic will be maintained, although there may be lane closures on Diablo Road. Parking may be temporarily unavailable and some turning movements may be limited. Disruption to intersections will only occur at night.

Brief interruptions in water service are expected when connections are made to the existing water main and individual services are transferred. EBMUD will notify customers ahead of time.

Work on the project began in early January 2014 and is expected to be completed in March 2014.



The water main rupture on July 4, 2013 caused flooding and roadway damage. Permanent pipeline replacement is now underway.
