Insider's Guide TO DANVILLE IMPROVEMENTS

Railroad Avenue Improvements



Railroad Avenue between Church and School Streets

PROJECT INFORMATION

In recent years, the Town has recognized the benefit of increasing the walkability of Railroad Avenue given its proximity to the Railroad Avenue Municipal Lot, the Museum of the San Ramon Valley, Iron Horse Trail and the popular Saturday Farmers' Market.

Beginning in spring of 2014, overhead power lines will be relocated underground, with the joint utility poles removed along the east of Railroad Avenue. Next, sidewalks will be installed with brick banding, antique street lights, and a new row of street trees. Landscaped bulb-outs will align with patterned crosswalks that provide visual character and enhance pedestrian safety at key intersections. Finally, the road will be resurfaced to smooth any cracks or bumps that have developed over time.

To alleviate potential impacts on the community, construction will be completed in phases. A twelve month construction period is expected for all roadwork. Traffic control is expected to allow for two-way traffic during construction.
